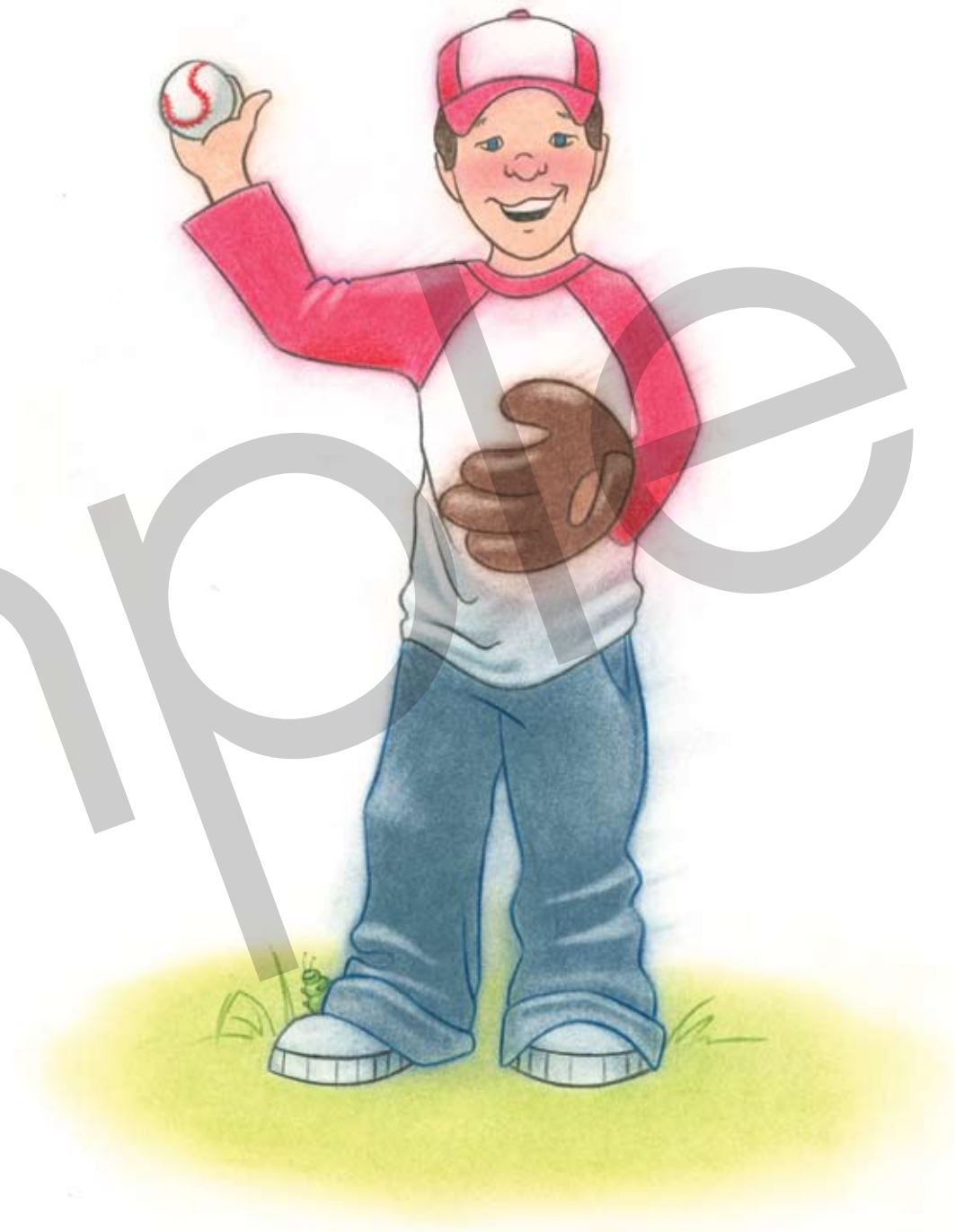

Reading Helps

Capital and Lower Case Letters: Letters have both an upper (capital) and a lower case.

Capitalize Names: Names begin with capital letters.

Blending Sounds: Letter sounds slide or blend smoothly together from left to right to form words.
